Mealtimes unfold in various locations, occasionally with show kitchens for added sophisticated theatrical flair. Dining takes place in the main restaurant and the outdoor boma or — by special request — in the privacy of guests’ suite or villa, or in the intimate bird hide.

A variety of dining styles is embraced, from floating breakfasts, harvest tables, à la carte menu options and casual, grab-and-go salad lunches to boma braais, buffet dinners, as well as elevated bush dining with fine dining flair.

Sustainability conscious dining

Our culinary team prepares fresh, flavourful masterpieces for every dish, inspired by local, traditional African cuisine. Menu items have been meticulously curated with sustainability in mind, using fresh, authentic ingredients sourced predominantly from our own garden, The Orchard.

We focus on growing indigenous produce in our garden, enabling the use of hyper-local ingredients, but also rely on other local suppliers which allows us to support nearby community members.

Guests are afforded the opportunity to harvest produce and learn about these food items and how they are grown during guided tours of The Orchard.

SUSTAINABILITY AT BUPENYU LODGE

The culinary journey at every meal

Bupenyu translates to the state of being alive. With appreciation for our surroundings, abounding in various life forms, we desire to conserve the ecosystem and preserve the natural splendour that is characteristic of this region. We do so in the following ways:

- Leveraging solar energy — We have installed over 700 solar PV panels that generate renewable energy for use at the lodge.
- Using sustainably sourced potable water — We use water from our well points and water storage to water our gardens, thereby reducing our demand on this valuable resource.

- Growing indigenous produce in our onsite garden — We cultivate our own produce, including fresh fruits, vegetables and herbs. This enables us to use seasonal ingredients and to foster a culture of sustainability among our staff and guests.

Supporting surrounding communities

We also have a heart for helping nearby communities to improve their livelihoods. We do so in the following ways:

- Employing local workers — At Bupenyu Lodge, we are committed to creating meaningful opportunities for the local community. The majority of our team is proudly made up of skilled individuals from the Victoria Falls area, ensuring authentic hospitality while supporting sustainable livelihoods. Through training, employment, and development initiatives, we invest in the people who make this place truly special.

Guided tour of the Victoria Falls

Bask in the splendour of the Victoria Falls, from the two distinct perspectives in Zimbabwe and Zambia.

During a guided tour of the Victoria Falls, you are able to enjoy panoramic views of the famous falls from Zimbabwe and experience closer proximity to this famous attraction from Zambia.

The waterfall is one of the largest in the world, at 1.7 km wide and over 100 m tall.

It is recommended that guests wear comfortable walking shoes, sun protection and a water-proof bag where valuable items can be protected. Border crossing is necessary during this tour.

Helicopter flights over Victoria Falls

Referred to as the “Flight of Angels”, the incredible helicopter trip over the Victoria Falls offers you a unique perspective of this majestic landmark and its lush surroundings.

These flights give you the chance to appreciate the grandeur of the Victoria Falls. Depending on the duration of the flight, you may also have the opportunity to see more of the Batoka Gorge and park regions where wildlife could also be spotted from above.

Zambezi River boat cruises

Recline and absorb the raw beauty that characterises the Zambezi River and its surroundings.

Zambezi River boat cruises are a relaxing way to experience the region’s scenery and sights, from the vast waters to the contrasting landscape, diverse wildlife and abundant birdlife.

Cruises typically take place over a few hours and at various times of the day in different formats, including breakfast, lunch and sunset options. Sunset cruises are particularly special and a popular choice among many visitors.

Black rhino conservation experience

Embark on a guided journey to discover the endangered black rhino.

Take the rare opportunity to encounter the endangered black rhino in the Victoria Falls Private Game Reserve. Led by a private guide, you will be taken on a game drive through the reserve and will gain meaningful insights into the conservation efforts that have taken place over the last 20 years to protect this magnificent species.

Horse riding along Batoka Gorge

Enjoy an exhilarating and immersive guided tour of the gorge on horseback.

Embark on a stunning guided tour of scenic trails through unspoiled African bush, along the Batoka Gorge where majestic wildlife and birdlife may be spotted in their splendid natural environment. Daring swim at Devil’s Pool

For the truly bold, take a dip on the edge of Victoria Falls.

Set on the very edge of the Victoria Falls, above a 100 metre drop, this natural rock pool gives the intrepid adventurer the thrilling chance of swimming in a naturally formed infinity pool that will undoubtedly get the adrenaline pumping.

Millions of litres of water cascade over the falls every minute, making this activity for the fearless. The experience is only offered during certain times of the year and in certain conditions, during the low-water season, and must be booked with a guide.

Day trip into Chobe National Park

Discover the wonders of Botswana’s famous Chobe National Park during a guided safari or a river cruise.

A short transfer from the luxury boutique lodge, Chobe National Park — characterised by savannah land, lush floodplains and dense woodlands — offers a spectacular safari experience led by an experienced guide, in search of the region’s exquisite land- and water-based wildlife.

For those seeking a different vantage point, a leisurely cruise along the Chobe River can be enjoyed, where the park’s rich wildlife and natural beauty can be enjoyed as part of a captivating experience.

Day trip into Hwange National Park

Experience the unspoilt beauty of Zimbabwe’s largest, iconic national park.

Set near to the Botswana and Zambia international borders, Hwange National Park is home to one of Africa’s largest elephant populations and hundreds of mammal and bird species.

Embark on a guided safari into the heart of this magnificent park, characterised by savannahs, forests and waterholes — the perfect setting for memorable game viewing.

This full-day adventure captures the very essence of Zimbabwe’s natural scenery and wildlife.

Bushtracks Express steam train experience and dinner

Chinotimba Township Tour

Embark on a culturally enriching and insightful guided tour of a local township. Chinotimba refers to the roar of the Victoria Falls in the local Nambya language. The majority of people in the Victoria Falls region, approximately 60 000, live in the Chinotimba Township.

This tour provides visitors to the area with a significant opportunity to experience a glimpse into this vibrant township and to have sincere interactions with local community members, deepening their understanding of the challenges that these people face, the triumphs they experience, and the culture, history and daily practices that they embrace.

The guided tour takes participants to significant landmarks, where traditional cuisine can be sampled and cultural activities and local artistry can be admired. Moreover, it takes visitors on a journey of cultural appreciation.

LODGE ACCESS

PLEASE NOTE:

There is a dirt road from the main tar road to the luxury boutique lodge, which is 16 km long and takes approximately 25 minutes to drive.

DISTANCES:

- From airport to lodge: 25.2 km including dirt road (9.2 km excluding dirt road)
- From lodge to Zambia border bridge: 28 km including dirt road (12 km excluding dirt road)
- From lodge to Victoria Falls (Zimbabwe): 28 km including dirt road (12 km excluding dirt road)

What is Bupeyu Lodge’s child & extra bed policy?

No children under the age of 16 years are permitted at the Lodge.
Children 16 years and older are considered adults and would require their own rooms and applicable single or sharing rate.

What should I pack for my stay?

What is special about the area where Bupenyu Lodge is located?

Bupenyu Lodge is located above Rapid no. 22 in the Batoka Gorge, along the Zambezi River, between Zimbabwe and Zambia. The most significant attraction in the broader region is undoubtedly the famous Victoria Falls — the world’s largest sheet of falling water and a World Heritage Site. This is one of Africa’s most unforgettable attractions.

The gorge is dramatically beautiful — with awe-inspiring cliffs and unique basalt formations — and holds geological significance. Diverse ecosystems and various wildlife species add to the area’s appeal, which is known to draw visitors from around the globe. Activities such as white-water rafting, bungee jumping and zip lining also attract adventure seekers from near and far.

What is the weather like in the Batoka Gorge region of Zimbabwe?

Batoka Gorge is characterised by a semi-arid subtropical climate, with hot summers (October to March). The rainy season (November to March) brings high humidity levels and occasional thunderstorms. Winters (June to August) are mild to cool, and the dry season (April to October) typically offers clear skies and ideal conditions for outdoor activities.

The average annual temperature in Batoka Gorge typically ranges from **23°C to 35°C**.
