An untamed African experience awaits at Nkomazi Private Game Reserve, surrounded by towering mountains, broad river valleys and impressive grasslands.

This piece of land, south-west of the Kruger National Park, stretches out over 15 000 hectares is home to a diverse ecosystem that supports both Highveld and Lowveld game species, as well as an abundance of birdlife. This makes for spectacular game viewing and a unique safari experience.

At the Nkomazi Private Game Reserve, true tranquillity is found. The lodge is characterised by the Komati River which continuously emits a gentle rumble. This reminder of one's proximity to nature complements the tranquil atmosphere that is felt throughout Nkomazi Private Game Reserve. Steeped in history, the reserve is home to some of the oldest rock formations on earth, embellished by ancient San rock art.

ACCOMMODATION

Our lodge is situated on the banks of the Komati River, providing guests with a true African glamping experience.

The camp comprises fourteen state-of-the-art tents, each furnished in an "Out of Africa" style with all the comforts of luxury accommodation. The tents blend into the natural landscape and are linked by stoned pathways through the bush.

HONEYMOON TENTS





Comfortable and relaxing chairs that are spread out at the Main Tent beckon guests to relax in this peaceful setting. 




FISHING

Fishing can be enjoyed along the 30 kilometers of the Komati River as it winds its way through Nkomazi Private Game Reserve. This awe-inspiring and adventurous activity is offered on a catch-and-release basis, at an additional cost, and is subject to weather and river conditions.

Rangers are on hand to provide basic tuition and guidance.
The cost is R350.00 per person, including rod.

ABOUT MPUMALANGA

Mpumalanga, which means “place where the sun rises”, is situated on the eastern side of South Africa and is one of the country’s nine provinces. It is home to a diverse range of fauna and flora which makes it a remarkable destination. World-famous attractions such as the Kruger National Park, Pilgrim’s Rest, the Blyde River Canyon and God’s Window are all located in this region.

The province is divided longitudinally into the Highveld, on the west, and the Lowveld, on the right. The Highveld is typically cooler than the Lowveld and experiences frosty winters whereas the Lowveld region has a subtropical climate, with milder winters. Summer brings rainfall and refreshing thunderstorms to the region.
