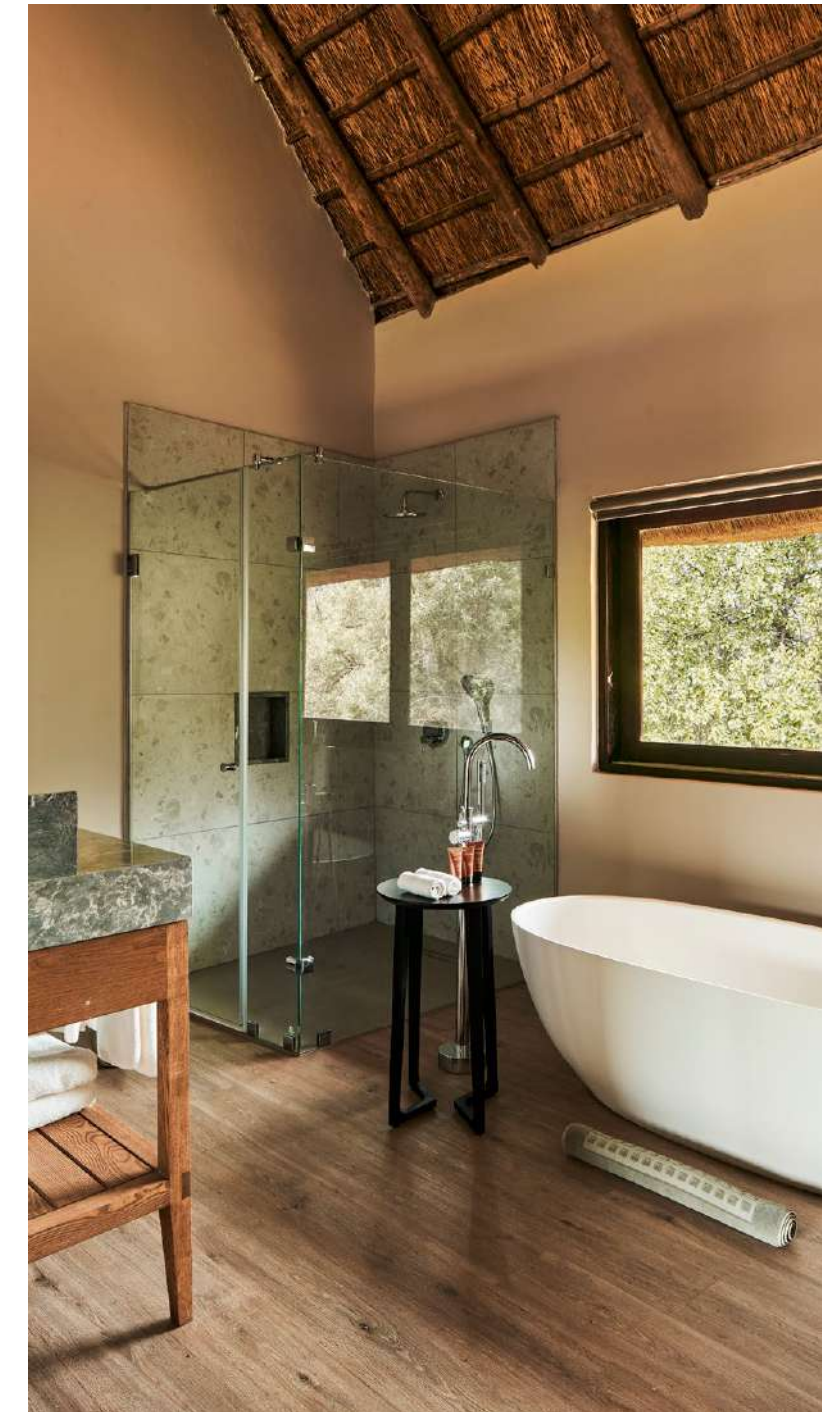

#### CHILD MINDING SERVICE

#### GENERAL POLICY

Children of all ages are welcome at LETAMO.

#### ACCOMMODATION GUIDELINES

- Camp Cots: Available for children aged 0–2 years, subject to availability.
- Rollaway Beds: Available for children aged 3–8 years, subject to availability.
  - Children aged 0–2 years stay free of charge in a cot.
  - Children aged 3–8 years may be accommodated on a rollaway bed in Premium Rooms and higher categories, at a nightly cost (maximum one child per room).

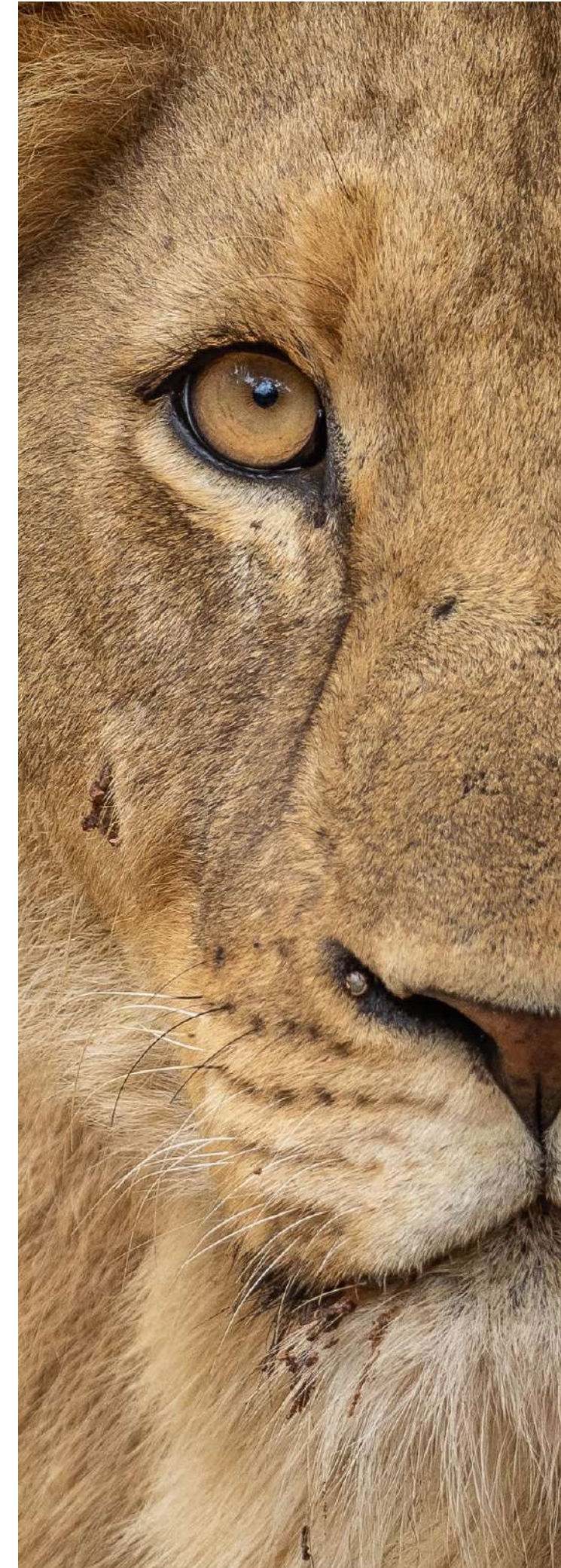
#### ROOM CONFIGURATION

Interleading rooms are available in Deluxe and Premium Rooms at LETAMO, subject to availability.

- One child (3–15 years): Charged 50% of the double adult occupancy rate.
  - Two children (3–15 years): Charged 75% of the double adult occupancy rate.
- This policy applies to children up to 15 years of age.

#### SAFARI & ACTIVITIES

- Children aged 6 years and older may join adult game drives at LETAMO.
- Children under 6 years may participate in a separate mid-morning family game drive on request, subject to availability.
- Guests must be 16 years or older to join safari, subject to the availability of Field Guides.
- Kids club: Supervision and child minders are available during operational hours





Two private breakaway rooms, each seating up to 15 delegates, offer more intimate spaces for strategy sessions, workshops and executive meetings. Throughout the venue, warm neutrals, textured finishes and contemporary furnishings create an environment designed to encourage both focus and comfort.

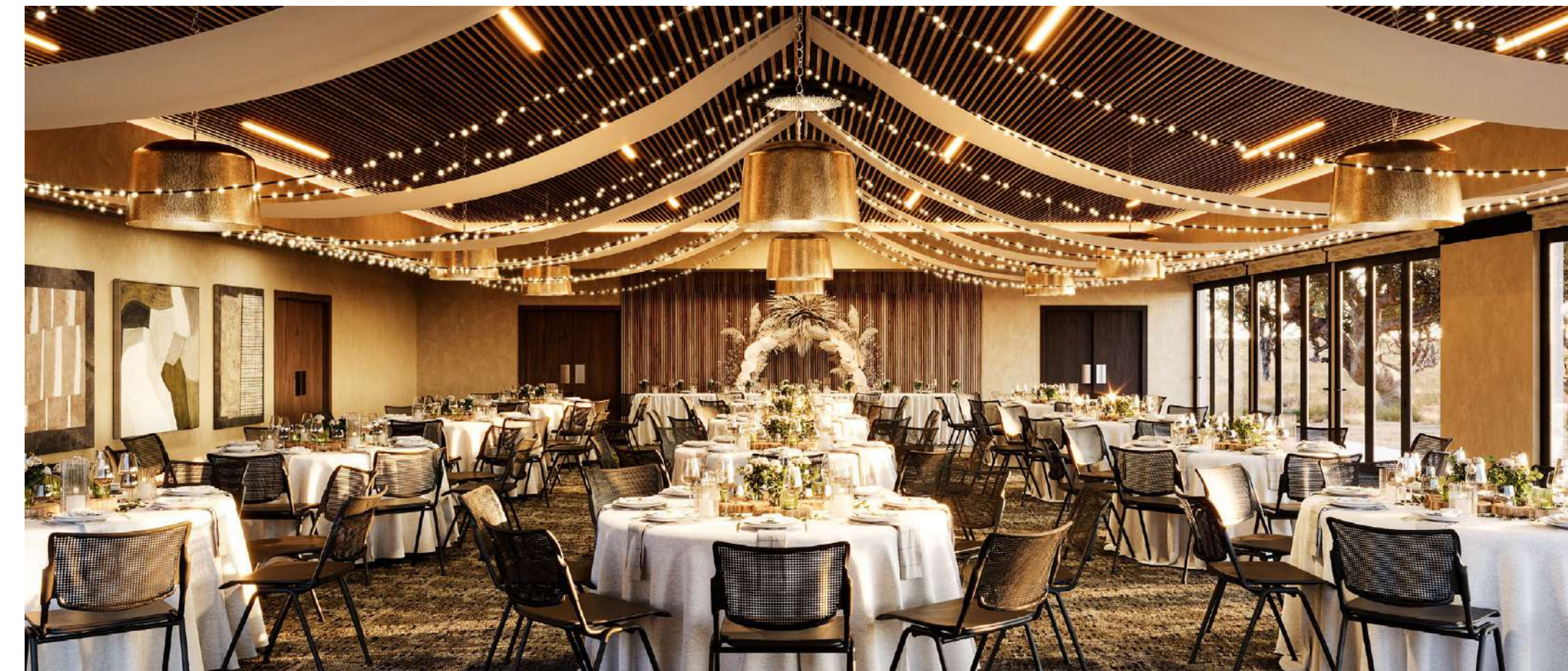
Arrival unfolds through a contemporary reception lobby and landscaped transitional spaces that maintain a constant connection to the surrounding wilderness. The venue further extends onto a shaded dining deck accommodating approximately 102 guests, alongside outdoor entertainment and breakout areas ideal for networking events, cocktail evenings and relaxed gatherings beneath the Waterberg sky.

More than a traditional conferencing venue, the QWABI Conference Centre has been designed as an immersive bushveld destination where business, celebration and contemporary African hospitality come together in a setting shaped by nature.

## QWABI CONFERENCE CENTRE

Set within the Waterberg Biosphere, the new QWABI Conference Centre offers a refined meeting and events destination where contemporary African design meets the natural rhythm of the bushveld. Designed as an extension of the wider QWABI experience, the venue combines natural textures, warm timber finishes, layered stone elements and curated African-inspired décor to create a space that feels both sophisticated and deeply connected to its surroundings.

At the centre of the facility is the main Conference Hall - a flexible 230m<sup>2</sup> venue accommodating up to 120 delegates in a cinema-style configuration. Designed to host everything from conferences and executive retreats to product launches, gala dinners and weddings, the space balances functionality with a quieter sense of luxury through acoustic wood panelling, high-volume ceilings, premium finishes and integrated presentation technology. Large-format screens, seamless audiovisual integration and carefully considered lighting ensure the venue transitions effortlessly between business and social events.

## ABOUT THE WATERBERG BIOSPHERE RESERVE

QWABI is located within the Waterberg Biosphere Reserve, which forms part of the greater Waterberg Region in the province of Limpopo, South Africa. This reserve is one of only two UNESCO-declared savannah biospheres in Africa and is recognised as a critical biodiversity area by the South African National Biodiversity Institute. Known for its exquisite natural beauty and abundance of wildlife, including the Big Five, and birdlife, the Waterberg region gives guests a taste of authentic African wilderness.

The landscape has been relatively untouched by humans and few tarred roads exist in the area, giving those who visit an immersive bush experience. The region is also home to rivers, natural pans and streams, breathtaking mountain gorges and rock formations.

It's an area rich in scenic splendour, in restorative ambiance and in cultural depth.
